Research and Publications

Recent output includes articles in publications such as *Second Language Acquisition Theory, Challenges Encountered by Chinese ESL Learners* and *TESOL Quarterly*. Such activities are supported by funding from a range of sources such as the Research Grants Council, Teaching Development Grants, and the Louis Cha Fund.
